2024 CYIA & JR. CYIA SUMMER MISSIONARIES

1 Chronicles 16:24 tells us to, "Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!" This is one of many verses that calls people to world missions. Sharing the gospel with people in other countries is very admirable and rewarding, and anybody who serves God in this way should be proud of their work. However, one should not confuse the command to share the gospel with becoming an oversees missionary. There are plenty of people, in our community who need to hear the gospel. With this information in mind, I would like to present your teenager with an opportunity to participate in a local mission's opportunity through CYIA.

CYIA is a two-week program that teaches teenagers how to effectively share the gospel with children. They will learn skills that will be valuable to them for a lifetime. To name a few, they will gain leadership skills, they will learn how to prepare and teach lessons, and how to organize and lead children in activities. Once they have learned the skills, they will then have an opportunity to help lead a 5-day club to a group of children.

CYIA & Jr. CYIA for the Greater Kansas City Area

This year CYIA will be held in Warrenton, MO, from June 2-8, and in Kansas City from June 10-14. This year, we're offering five full CYIA scholarships. Also, the first 10 students to submit their applications will receive a \$50 discount on their fees. Jr. CYIA will be held in Columbia, MO on May 4th, and two full Jr. CYIA scholarships will be given. The first five students to apply will receive a \$20 fee reduction.
